Camp Efigenio C Navarro, Calapan City- Though the personnel of the Philippine National Police were ordered to cease and desist from conducting anti-illegal operations like buy-bust, service of search warrant, continuous monitoring and evaluation is still being conducted by the Regional Oversight Committee on Illegal Drugs of Police Regional Office MIMAROPA on the declaration of the "Drug-Free" and "Drug Cleared" barangays.

From the fifty-five (55) total number of "Drug-Free" barangays which were declared "Drug-Free" of January 2017, an additional seventy (70) barangays were also declared "Drug-Free" and an additional ten (10) barangays were already declared "Drug Cleared" as of February 6, 2017. As of this time, there were one hundred twenty-five (125) total number of barangays that were declared "Drug-Free" and sixteen (16) barangays that were declared "Drug-Cleared".

The seventy (70) "Drug Free" Barangays were the fourteen (14) Barangays from the municipality of **Sta. Cruz, Marinduque** namely barangays Punong, Pantayin, San Isidro, Kaganhao, Lamesa, Hupi, Dolores, Banogbog Haguimit, Kinyaman, Libjo, Labo, Pulong Parang and Tambangan; six (6) barangays from the municipality of

Torrijos

namely barangays Kay Duke, Pakaskasan, Cagpo, Malinao, Mabuhay and Bolo; seven (7) barangays from the municipality of the municipality of

Since the President RODRIGO R DUTERTE suspended the police operations against illegal drugs, PCSUPT WILBEN M MAYOR, Regional Director instructed all the Provincial Directors and City Director to concentrate their operations on the seven (7) focus crimes, police community relations activities and on internal cleansing.
